## **ANNUAL REPORT (2024–25)**

A very warm and pleasant evening to each one of you.

It gives me immense pride and privilege, as the Principal of CMS College of Engineering, to present before you the Annual Report for the academic year 2024–25.

### **Academic Performance**

In the recent Anna University examinations, our college achieved an overall pass percentage of 30%. While this result reflects areas needing improvement, I am pleased to inform you that our dedicated faculty members have been working tirelessly to enhance academic outcomes. We anticipate a significant improvement, with the pass percentage expected to exceed 50% in the ongoing semester.

### **Facility Enhancements**

To improve health and safety for our hostel students—both boys and girls—we have initiated the process to procure an ambulance, ensuring timely medical attention during emergencies.

In addition, we are planning to acquire a battery-powered vehicle to facilitate the movement of parents and guests within the campus during their visits.

A major infrastructural addition in the pipeline is a new auditorium with a seating capacity of 2000. We are hopeful that our current final-year students will return to this auditorium to celebrate their Graduation Day in 2027. The auditorium will also include dedicated parking areas for both two-wheelers and cars, benefitting our day scholars and staff members.

### **Laboratory and Infrastructure Developments**

In line with the latest technological advancements, we have upgraded all computers in the CSE, AI&DS, Cyber Security, and ECE departments to i7 processors, ensuring a seamless and faster learning experience for our students.

We have also established new facilities by investing over ₹15 lakhs to set up the Embedded Systems & IoT Lab and Diagnostic Lab, which are now being utilized by our Biomedical Engineering students.

### **Library and ERP Integration**

Our library has adopted a new digital management system, MODERNLIB, which allows students and faculty easy access to academic resources. Furthermore, the college website is currently being revamped to enhance information delivery and ensure remote access to library facilities.

To streamline administrative processes, we have also implemented an ERP software named IMPRESS, which integrates admissions, academic records, attendance, fee payments, and other functions into a single, unified platform. This not only reduces manual workload but also improves decision-making and communication. Parents can now monitor their ward's academic progress in real time through this system.

### **National Service Scheme (NSS) Activities**

Our NSS unit has been highly active and vibrant throughout the year, taking part in numerous social service initiatives both within and beyond the campus. These include blood donation camps, awareness programs on women's safety, anti-drug and anti-tobacco campaigns, as well as environmental initiatives like tree plantation and cleanliness drives.

In recognition of its contributions, our college was honoured with the Best Social Service Award by Sarvam Educational Trust, Namakkal District. The award was proudly received from Hon'ble Rajya Sabha Member Thiru. K.R.N. Rajesh Kumar on 12th January 2025.

### **Placement and Industry Collaboration**

Under the leadership of our Placement Director, Mrs. Mahalakshmi Sridhar, our placement activities have seen notable progress. Nearly 75% of the recently passed-out batch received job offers, with several students securing multiple placements.

We have signed Memoranda of Understanding (MoUs) with several industries to foster internship and placement opportunities:

With Global Medical Coding Academy, Thanjavur, to support Biomedical Engineering (BME) students. A 14-day training in Medical Coding was conducted for BME students this March.

With TAP Academy, Bengaluru, to train CSE and AI&DS final-year students in technical skills, commencing from August 4th.

With Coral Manufacturing Works India Pvt. Ltd., Erode, and United Manufacture India Pvt. Ltd., Salem, for the benefit of Mechanical Engineering students.

Turnon Energy India Pvt. Ltd., Erode, has assured recruitment for all EEE students upon their eligibility through an MoU.

Krish Precisions, Erode, an aerospace company, has signed an MoU to support ECE and Mechanical students.

Looking ahead, we are expecting a partnership with Ashok Leyland in the coming week—an exciting milestone that will expand our reach and impact in industry collaboration and innovation.

### **Recognition and Accreditations**

We are proud to announce that the college has been accredited by the National Assessment and Accreditation Council (NAAC). Building on this, we have commenced the process for gaining autonomy status, aiming to provide greater academic flexibility and curriculum design.

Furthermore, we are working with a vision to achieve NBA accreditation for all eligible programs by 2028.
