Autonomous Status

I am delighted to share a significant milestone in our institution's journey. From this academic year, our college will most likely function as an Autonomous Institution. We are awaiting the official notification from the University Grants Commission (UGC), New Delhi, which will formalize this achievement.

This transformation marks a new era for our institution—empowering us with academic flexibility, curriculum innovation, and enhanced quality standards.

Controller of Examinations

In preparation for autonomy, we have established a fully equipped Office of the Controller of Examinations with the necessary infrastructure, equipment, and qualified staff. This office will commence its operations from April 2026, ensuring smooth and transparent conduct of all examination-related activities.

Laboratory and Infrastructure Developments

Keeping pace with technological advancements, we have upgraded all computers in the CSE, AI&DS, Cyber Security, and ECE departments with i7 processors, thereby providing a faster and more efficient learning environment for our students.

To enhance students' communication and language proficiency skills, a separate Language Laboratory has also been established this year.

Library and ERP Integration

Our Central Library continues to function efficiently through the digital management system MODERNLIB, enabling easy access to academic resources.

In addition, we have successfully implemented an ERP software named IMPRESS, which integrates admissions, academic records, attendance, fee payments, and various administrative functions into a single unified platform. This initiative has significantly reduced manual workload, improved transparency, and enhanced communication among stakeholders. Parents can now monitor the academic progress of their wards in real time.

To promote quick reference and subject-specific learning, each department now maintains its own Department Library. Soon, we will integrate these collections with MODERNLIB to provide digital access to departmental resources as well.

Furthermore, our college website is currently being revamped to improve information dissemination and facilitate remote access to library services.

Academic Performance

In the recent Anna University examinations, our college achieved an overall pass percentage of 34%. While this indicates scope for improvement, I am confident that with the dedicated efforts of our faculty and the determination of our students, we will witness remarkable progress.

We anticipate a substantial improvement in the ongoing semester, with the pass percentage expected to exceed 60%.

National Service Scheme (NSS) Activities

Our NSS unit has been highly active and vibrant throughout the year. The volunteers have organized and participated in numerous social initiatives, including:

- Anti-drug and anti-tobacco campaigns

Sports Achievements

This year has been remarkable in terms of sports accomplishments.

On 15th and 16th October 2025, our students secured Second Place in the Decathlon at the Anna University Zone VIII Level Athletics Competition held at Selvam College of Technology, Namakkal.

On 17th October 2025, our students achieved Third Place in Handball at the Anna University Zone VIII Level Sports Competition conducted at Paavai College of Engineering.

On 6th November 2025, our team secured Second Place in Kho-Kho, again at Paavai College of Engineering.

On 8th February 2026, our students secured 2nd, 3rd, and 4th places in the National Voter Awareness Marathon organized by the District Administration, Namakkal District—closely missing the first position. Indeed, these are commendable achievements that bring pride to our institution.

Placement and Industry Collaboration

With regard to placements, I am proud to announce that nearly 90% of the recently passed-out batch received job offers, with several students securing dual placements.

In the current final-year batch, a significant number of students have secured internship opportunities across various industries:

AI&DS – 38 students in 7 companies

CSE – 49 students in 6 companies

BME – 13 students in 9 companies

ECE – 11 students in 2 companies

EEE – 5 students in 3 companies

Mechanical – 3 students in 1 company

We have strengthened industry collaboration through several MoUs:

We have become a member of the Indian Biomedical Skill Consortium, Visakhapatnam, an organization focused on certification systems for Biomedical Engineers under the National Skill Development framework of the Government of India.

Our MoU with Cosma Technology, Bengaluru has enabled 6 ECE students to secure job offers. They are currently undergoing internship and project training at the company and will be absorbed as employees upon graduation in June 2026.

Finest Coders & Codingmart, a skill development company, has signed an MoU to support students from all branches with advanced technical training.
